# HAMLET ACT V: BACKGROUND INFORMATION

## CONFLICT

P. 161 l. 118 „Did these bones cost no more the breeding but to play at loggats with' ,em? Mine ache to think on't.”  
Hamlet talks about the worth of a humans life and their corpse's.

Conflict: Hamlet loved Ophelia and think she should get a better Grave and a ceremony for her death. He is talking about the death of people and how much respect we have to give those who died. He is also willing to fight Leasters to show his love to the now dead Ophelia.

Conflict 2: Hamlet shows his hate towards Claudius, not only because he killed his father but also because he “whored” his mother. In the Fight between Hamlet and Leartes suddenly his mother dies of the poisoned drink from Claudius. Hamlet won the fight against Leartes but not flawless, his kills Claudius and in the end dies himself

- she is cheering for her son and drinks the glass of poison while wishing him the victory's fight

- He talks about the death of Hamlet and his way into heaven

## MORALITY

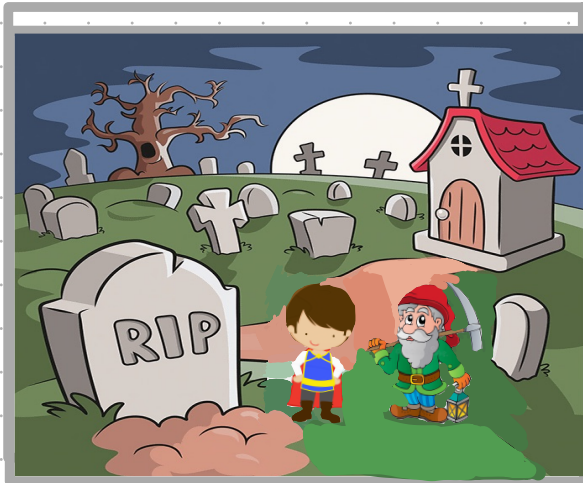

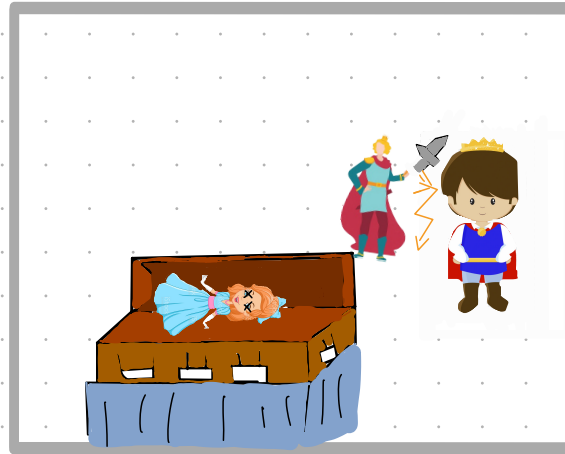


-Two gravediggers discuss if Ophelia should get a christian funeral

Scene

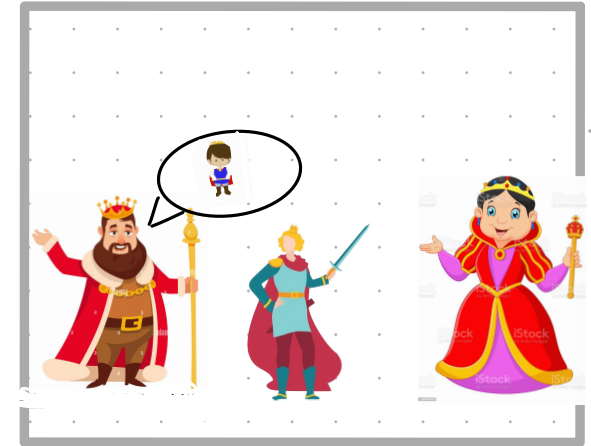


-Hamlet joins when he realises that it is Ophelias Funeral

-Claudius tells Gertrude to hire someone to keep an eye on Hamlet

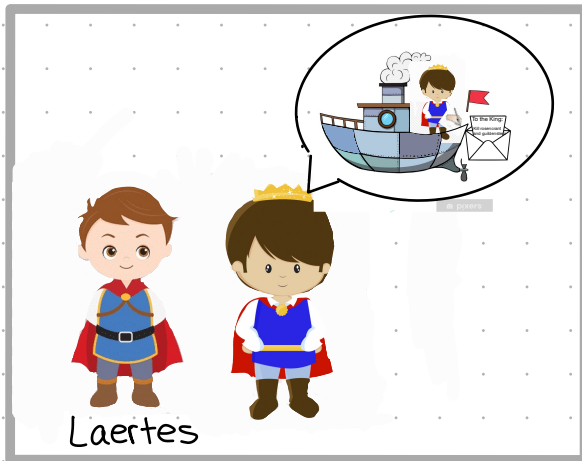
-Claudius tells Laertes to be patient and reminds him of his plan

## Scene



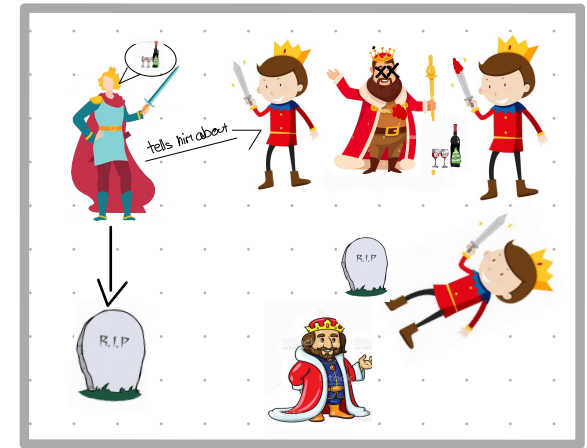
- Hamlet tells Horatio what happened while he was out of Denmark
- found a letter from Claudius that tells the King to have Hamlet killed
- He altered the letter without them knowing to tell the king that the bearers of the letter (i.e. Rosencrantz and Guildenstern) should be killed
- Hamlet gets an invitation to fight a friendly duel with Laertes based on a bet

## Scene



- Hamlet apologized to Laertes, tells him that Polonius' death was an accident
- Laertes accepts the apology but still wants to fight as he doesn't want to look like a fool
- Laertes takes a poisoned sword
- Claudius offers Hamlet poisoned wine
- He declines but his mother drinks it and dies
- Laertes tells Hamlet their plan
- admits that the wine and sword is poisoned

## Scene



- Hamlet stabs Claudius and makes him drink the poisoned wine (he dies)
- Laertes dies
- Hamlet notices that he will die as well and that Horatio should tell the world what happened
- Horatio refuses and tries to drink out of the cup but Hamlet restrains him
- Hamlet declares Fortinbras should become the next king of Denmark
- Fortinbras arrives with his army and ascends the Danish throne
- Horatio shares some information with Fortinbras
